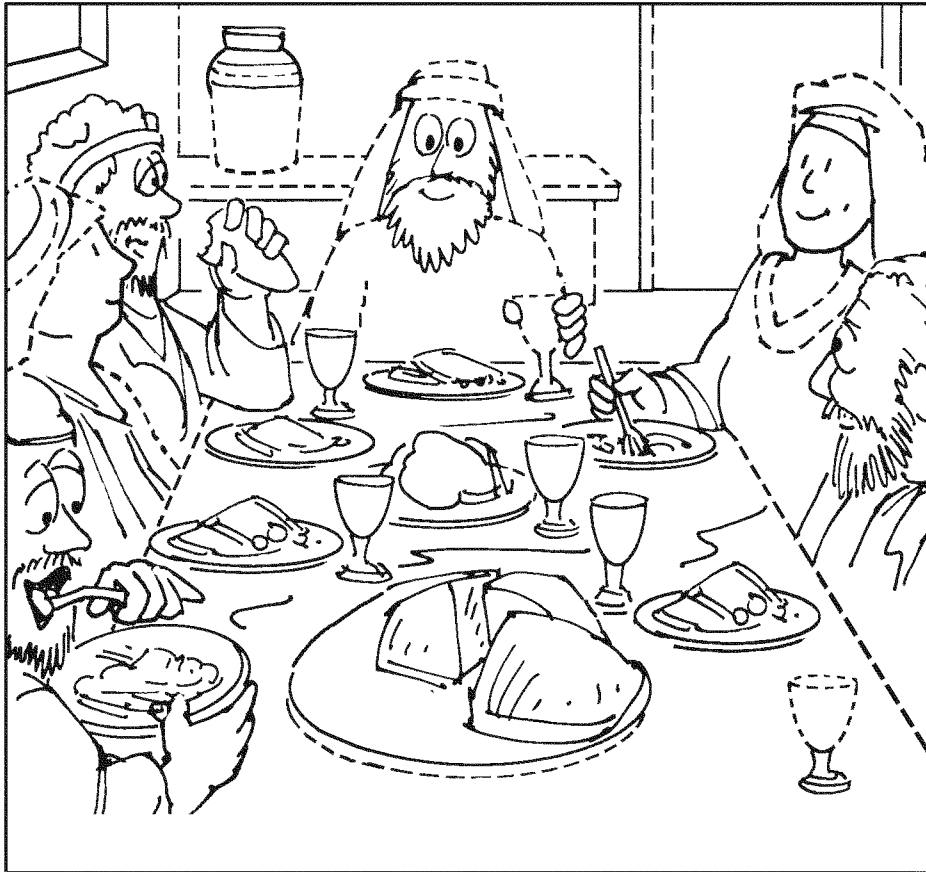
The servant told Isaac all he had done.
